As a reply to your letter nr 116/ 4<sup>th</sup> Sept 2012 in which you demand, in accordance to the provisions of the 544 / 2011 Law in regard to the free access to public interest information, explanations regarding some documents prepared by the Police Traffic Division to the Streets Administration, following the examination we inform you the following:

1. The Police Traffic Division did not give permits for the cycle lanes from the General Gh. Magheru Blvd or Nicolae Balcescu Blvd;
2. The developments happening at this point on the mentioned boulevards are being executed by a firm specialized in road developments, under a contract with the Streets Administration, on the basis of the Authorization of Intervention on the Public Domain issued to this institution by the Mayor's Office. The developments to the town's network or to the roads are announced and recorded by phone by the Mayor's Office and also by the Police Traffic Division;
3. The routes on which the cycle lanes were requested to be closed down temporarily in 2012:
  - ↓ Dimitrie Cantemir Blvd., between Gh. Sincai Blvd. and Marasesti Blvd;
  - ↓ Carol Blvd., Regina Elisabeta Blvd. and Mihail Kogalniceanu Blvd., between 21 Decembrie 1989 Square and Operei Square ;
  - ↓ Romana Square – Lascar Catargiu Blvd. – Victoriei Square – Kiseleff Blvd.– Arcul de Triumf Square – Presei Libere Square ;
  - ↓ Bucovina Str. – Basarabia Blvd.;
  - ↓ 13 Septembrie Avenue, between Izvor Str. and M. Sebastian Str.;
  - ↓ Viilor Avenue, between Odoarei Str. and Serban Voda Avenue;
  - ↓ Plevnei Avenue, between Berzei Str. and Orhideelor Avenue;
  - ↓ Iancu de Hunedoara Blvd.;
  - ↓ Ghencea Blvd.;
  - ↓ Stefan cel Mare Avenue;
  - ↓ Unirii Blvd.;
  - ↓ Tudor Vladimirescu Blvd.;
  - ↓ Theodor Pallady Blvd.;
  - ↓ Mihai Bravu Avenue, between Vacărești Avenue and Hurmuzachi Square;
4. The Streets Administration requested to the Technical Committee for Traffic, during August 2012, the re-approval of the cycle lane on Theodor Pallady Blvd., a project that the Police Traffic Division

voted against of, since the sidewalks of this boulevard have parking lots on them and the access points to these parking lots are over the route proposed for the cycle lane;

5. The Police Traffic Division applied a contraventional sanction to the Streets Administration for the development of the cycle lane on the Th. Pallady Blvd. without a notice from the traffic police, for the rest of the deficiencies transmitted to the road administrator we will apply sanctions in the event in which, after the assignment of the contracts regarding the acquisition of road signs, the cycle lanes will not be closed down.
